Tournament Rules

1. Registration Sign-up: 10am-2pm
2. Contestants must complete release of liability forms prior to the event.
3. All contestants will fish in accordance with current Wisconsin State and local Fishing and Boating Regulations.
4. Fishing hours are 11am - 3pm. Must be in line at registration by 3pm for fish to count.
5. All Juniors must be accompanied by an adult.
6. No alcoholic beverages allowed during fishing hours.
7. Unlimited anglers per boat allowed.
8. All occupants of your boat must be registered, paid contestants. If a guide is hired, he/she must be a paid contestant.
9. Three lines per person.
10. Artificial and Live Bait are permitted.

11. Shoreline fishing is allowed.
12. Awards categories:

 - Longest Crappie - \$50
